

Safety Equipment

Required by the Forest Service:

- Shovel and Axe
- Fire Extinguisher
- Gallon of Water

Recommended Equipment:

- Spare tire
- Front and rear tow hooks
- Tow Strap
- Hi-Lift Jack
- CB Radio
- First Aid Kit
- Winch

Technical Inspection

- General condition tech (steering, brakes, lights) Battery tie down (NO BUNGEE CORDS)
- An Oregon State Class II O.R.V sticker is required.
- Primary elements for street legal status (licensed, current registration, turn signals, rear view mirrors, working lights, exhaust system)
- USFS requires spark arrestor on ALL vehicles. Glass packs or any straight-through mufflers that do not include spark arrestor certification are not allowed.

Everyone is required to check out before leaving on the trail run, and check in upon return. This is for your safety to make sure nobody is stuck or lost on the trails at the end of the day.

CTW 2006 Rules

All registered vehicles must be street legal, licensed, insured and equipped prior to the mandatory technical inspection.

The Cascade Cruisers are not responsible for accidents, damage, or injury to persons or vehicles. All drivers must be licensed and are responsible for the occupants of their vehicle. All occupants must be registered, paid for, and sign a waiver.

Running a non-designated trail anytime during CTW 2006 may result in disqualification from participation during this and future events.

Make sure you always maintain visual contact with the vehicle behind you on trail rides. Stop and wait for the vehicle behind you if you lose sight.

Weapons of any kind are not permitted in vehicles or at camp.

Consumption of alcohol is not permitted on trails.

Dogs are discouraged, but if brought must be on a leash at all times. Owners are responsible for clean up of all droppings.

Please minimize driving in campground. All drivers must be licensed.

Trail Runs:

- Each driver will be given a partial map on how to get to the next check point. At each checkpoint, you will be given another map to go to the next checkpoint.
- List of trails will be announced at the drivers meeting
- GPS route navigation will also be available.
